SUMMIT ENVIRONMENTAL WINS CONTRACT WITH STACY AND WITBECK

For Caltrans in District 7 – Malibu, California

Summit Environmental Contractors (SEC) will provide environmental contracting and consulting services along with the disposal and transportation of over 1,500 tons of contaminated soil for the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 7. Stacy and Witbeck has awarded SEC a contract valued at \$190,000 to remove hazardous materials and complete preliminary work prior to replacing the existing bridge with a new and improved concrete bridge. The new bridge will be 105 feet wide by 240 feet long and feature: two 12-foot traffic lanes, northbound and southbound traffic will be separated by a six-foot striped median, new bike lane, separate pedestrian lanes and 10-foot shoulders in each direction to substantially improve efficiency and safety for the community.

By removing this hazardous material, Summit is preventing toxic waste from migrating into the groundwater and beaches, helping reduce carbon emissions, protecting construction workers from health hazards and creating a healthier community for families. The preliminary work Summit Environmental Contractors will be completing will also include air monitoring, waste characterization, health and safety training, engineer support and site management.
